

ACTIVE Military are free to attend and must meet the following requirements: a) MUST have a Military ID, b) MUST have a valid Government Employee ID. Email address with .CTR@ (government contractors) or any other email addresses will invalidate registration. Registration will be cancelled if requirements are not met.

- after October 12, 2022 no refunds
